You have also applied to take the Advance session for 4 credits from the University of Maine Machias. The information sheet attached explains the additional required work, costs and how to create an account at UMM. If you no longer wish to take the course for credit, let me know ASAP to open the space for another student. You can still attend the session and receive the same educational experience.

If you are new to our programs, you will need a teacher/educator's recommendation for final acceptance. The teacher may complete the hard copy of the form (attached here) or go to our website (www.acadiainstitute.com) and complete it online. Homeschooled students should attempt to find someone they have worked with in an academic capacity before deferring to their own parent. You will be notified of final acceptance in writing after we receive a satisfactory recommendation. Acceptance is on a rolling basis.

While we're hopeful our Covid protocols will be loosened, the status of the virus is an unknown for summer 2023. Therefore, we must rely on current state, local and CDC guidelines to determine protocols with an understanding that they are likely to change. Since we won't have the CDC requirements for camps until next spring, you should not attend unless you're willing to abide by the protocols from summer 2022 if requested to do so. Besides our mitigations, these included being fully vaccinated and wearing masks inside. The science tells us that we are less likely to become severely ill or be hospitalized if we are fully vaccinated. Read current Covid-19 Protocols for summer 2023 to learn how AIO, with your support, will follow best practices as developed by the CDC.

To create a bubble of students and staff, Sunday arrival drop off will occur outside. Only students and staff will be allowed in the building on arrival. You may, however, tour the building at the end of the session pick-up and join us for a family lunch cookout if you're able. Arrival is between noon and 4 pm on the first Sunday. Stay in your car and allow the staff to guide you through the intake process before exiting your car to help your child unload. Departures will take place on the last Friday by noon to allow us time to deep clean before the next session. I've attached a list of lodging options if you choose to vacation in the area. We will also pick-up and drop-off students at the Bar Harbor airport or Bangor airport or bus stations, free of charge.

As a reminder, the deposit is not refundable as of March 1, 2023, and the balance of tuition is due May 1, 2023. If you would like to save \$60, pay the entire balance of the remaining tuition with a check or money order rather than a credit card before May 1, 2023 and deduct it from the total.

* These forms are **only** required for emergency medicines that a student must carry at all times (i.e. epi-pen, inhalers, diabetic medicines). If your child carries these emergency medications, you must also submit the doctor's action plan.
